## HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM

- ⇒ Decide whether you want to take a 'double' or 'triple' option.
- ⇒ If the answer is NO then choose four subjects from the single option block.
- ⇒ If the answer is YES then tick **one** double option or **one** triple option – then choose from the single option block using up your remaining choices.

For some pupils extra support will be provided within the option blocks and additional specialist college courses are available. **For further details please see Mr Mitchell or Mr Bevan.**

For pupils who are capable and well motivated we will consider allowing them to make two single option choices alongside a (triple) Diploma course. This will only be possible if pupils make a commitment to an additional hour a week after school to study the full diploma learning programme.
